Presenter Andrea Tschirner from Quorn taught participants how to select, propagate and care for native plants suited to the arid lands region. The 25 locals who attended had the opportunity to make a number of pots of hardy natives from cuttings to take home. Andrea was extremely generous with sharing her knowledge and experience with the eager group as they asked many questions. The participants also learned about seed collection and germination. Earlier Andrea had been at the Leigh Creek Area School assisting students with the school's useful plants garden. The workshop was part of a regional roadshow delivered by the South Australia Arid Lands Landscape Board.
