The Leigh Creek Resource Recovery Centre is now open!

Your Resource Recovery Centre (RRC) is ready to receive waste that would have previously have gone to landfill.

Acceptable items include plastic containers, plastic bottles, plastic wrap, cardboard, steel cans, aluminium packaging and much more.

There are also designated areas for you to drop off larger items such as scrap metal, e-waste, and car batteries.

How to use the recycling drive-through

It is very important that all household recyclables must first be sorted by category before placing in the separate bins. Each bin in the drive-through is clearly labelled to help you sort your waste into the correct waste-stream.

Refer to the sorting guide overleaf for separating your household recyclables. To reduce costs, and offer more options for recycling, we use the Terracycle program to recycle many waste items, so always check first if your items can be recycled in any of the Terracycle bins in the drive-through.

If you are in doubt whether a particular item can be recycled, leave it out to avoid bins being contaminated by unwanted items. Your attention to detail is highly important so that this service can continue to be made available to our community.

The Reuse Shop

Purchase second-hand goods or donate your unwanted reusable items. We only accept items that are in good clean condition, suitable for resale. The funds generated from the shop will contribute to the running costs of the RRC.

An environmental first for Outback SA

The Leigh Creek RRC is the first recycling drop-off point of its kind in Outback SA.

Leigh Creek is now proud to be part of the circular economy that reuses valuable resources. Support from the community is incredibly important to the success of our Resource Recovery Centre.

Although we are unable to accept certain items, we are continually striving to increase the range of recycling options available at the Leigh Creek RRC. So please check with us first before sending your rubbish to land fill.


